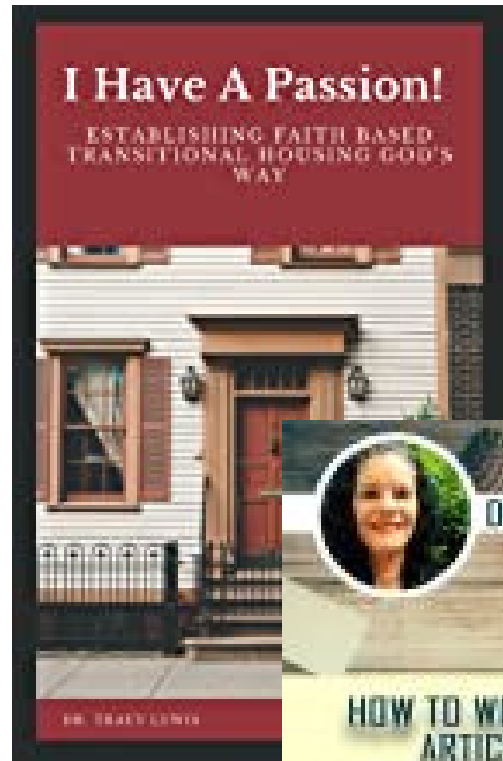
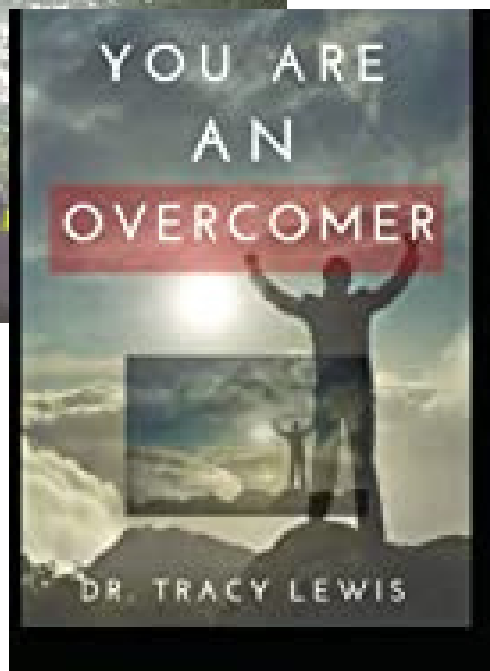
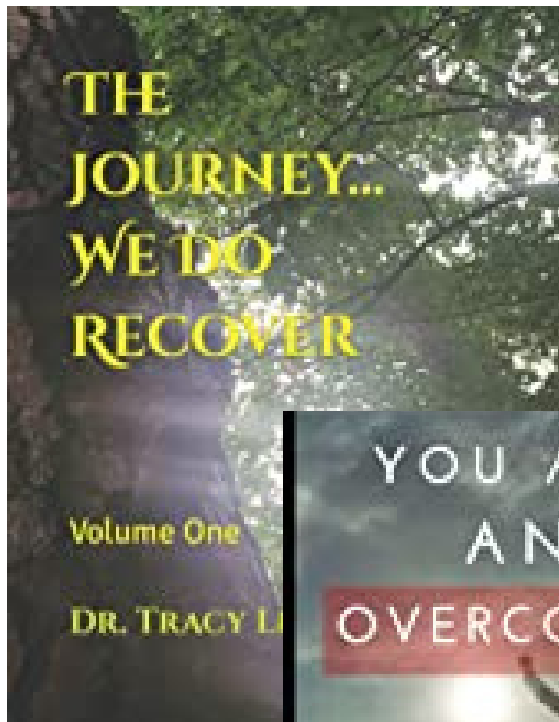

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES

Since 1997 G. D. O. M. has founded or helped establish over 23 churches, 3 bible institutes, initiated global mission projects in Africa, India, Philippines, Pakistan, Costa Rica, and Panama, and Bangladesh. This organization has also actively participated in clothing and food distributions to those in need throughout poverty-stricken areas of struggling communities and the world, 3 sober living homes with therapeutic support to date have been established in the state of Georgia. GDOM has conducted crusades, revivals, retreats, conferences, and grief support for men, women, ministers, and leaders, empowering others for works of service in the Kingdom. GDOM has also established an International Kingdom Recovery Community and developed and distributed publications, and media creations of video content including weekly podcasts.

New Direction Recovery Program is a faith-based supportive and therapeutic structured housing program that is an outreach program of GDOM. New Direction assists men and women who are coming from rehab, jail, accountability court programs, prison, shelters, and homelessness who are needing to recover from addiction, incarceration, domestic violence, divorce or other traumatic life experiences. It is a one-year faith-based program providing support and guidance in areas such as mental health awareness, substance abuse and relapse prevention, therapeutic intervention, spiritual growth, employment and educational development and financial stability through the supportive process of guidance, instruction and accountability.

Kingdom Recovery is a pathway to wholeness recovery with a network recovery community that has been established to offer such things as Recovery Meetings, Workbooks, Topical Conversational Zoom meetings with others in recovery, Gatherings for Fellowship with others in Recovery, Support Groups for different areas of recovery from divorce to sexual abuse, to addiction and families who are supporting and helping those who are battling addiction. We also provide transformational videos and uplifting, inspirational and instructional teachings and podcasts to overcome the obstacles to wholeness. This Pathway of Recovery has an initiative to combine biblical principles with therapeutic interventions and reaches people of all walks of life and ethnicities around the globe. Through our Big Book of Recovery, the Word of God and this Mission, we are restoring human wholeness and emotional healing to those who are suffering, bringing healing and full recovery to people spirit, soul and body.
